SCHNULL-RAUCH ENDOWMENT

The Schnull-Rauch House Endowment was established in 1987 and is held as a part of our Junior League Endowment. Its specific purpose is to provide the necessary funds for the restoration, renovation and upkeep of our beautiful historic home. The Schnull-Rauch House (SRH) was donated to the JLI in 1979 by John G. Rauch, Jr. We renovated it and then moved into it as our official headquarters in April of 1981. Gustav and Matilda Schnull originally built the SRH between 1902 and 1904. The house was designed by Bernard Vonnegut and was constructed in the French Romanesque style. It is a stately landmark at 3050 North Meridian Street.

The SRH just recently celebrated its 100th Anniversary! What better way to honor this architectural gem that not only provides a home to the Junior League of Indianapolis, but also to 21 other not-for-profit agencies through the years, than a gift to its Endowment.

TRUST FUND

The Junior League of Indianapolis Trust Fund directly benefits disabled children in Marion County. There are two specific funds within the Trust Fund:

- 1) *The Anne Collett Hensley Memorial Fund* - helps an Indianapolis child, under the age of 12, who is a cancer patient at Riley Hospital.
- 2) *The Emily Katherine Gilroy Memorial Fund* - provides emergency assistance to families of children who are patients at Riley Hospital.

A separate legal entity from the Junior League of Indianapolis, the JLI Trust Fund is governed by a Board of Trustees who meets annually. The JLI Trust Fund accepts letters of request for projects that fit the Trust Fund's mission as well as the mission of the two funds within the Trust Fund. Letters of request are due May 1 and should include: 1) Purpose of the project and how it qualifies, and 2) Amount of request with a brief description of needs.
